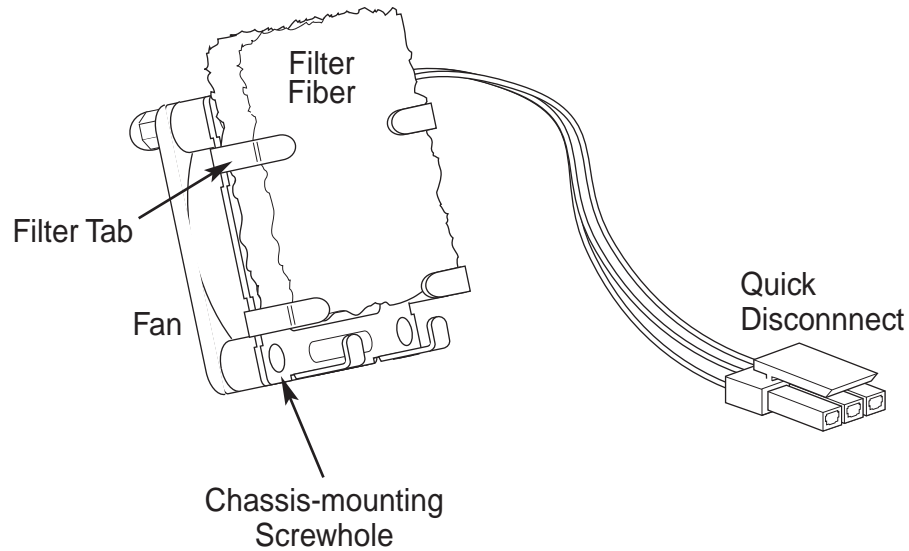
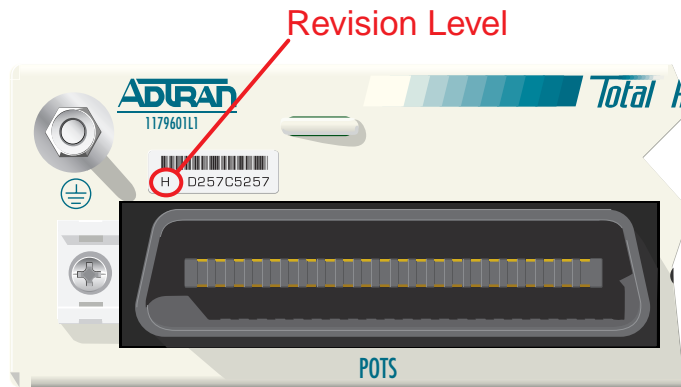


## TOTAL ACCESS 1200 REPLACEMENT FAN MODULE



### DESCRIPTION

Total Access® 1200 Chassis (P/N 1179601L1) with a revision level of A-G have two fan modules that are field replaceable with the replacement fan module (P/N 1179670L1). Look at the serial number located on the front panel of the Total Access 1200 chassis to determine the revision level. The figure below shows the serial number location and how to identify the chassis revision level.



### FAN MODULE REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

#### To remove fan module:

1. Remove the filter by pinching the center and pulling it away from the chassis.
2. Using a flathead screwdriver, remove the two screws from the fan module bracket.

*Note: The screws are to be reused. Do not discard.*

3. Remove the fan by pulling it straight out of the chassis.
4. Disconnect the fan by separating the power cable using the quick disconnect device.

#### To install new fan module:

1. Connect the fan by connecting the power cable lead from the fan to the power cable lead from the chassis using the quick disconnect device.
2. Insert the fan module into the chassis keeping the pre-drilled screw holes oriented at the bottom of the fan module.
3. Insert and tighten the two screws that were removed during the removal of the old fan module.
4. Install the new filter by tucking its edges behind the provided metal tabs.
